



**PUBLIC COMPETITION FOR ADMISSION TO THE PhD PROGRAMME IN FOOD SYSTEMS
(XXXIV cycle)**

Criteria for curriculum evaluation (max 20 points)

a. Student's career in university - max 12 points, determined based on the average of the marks obtained for the master's degree exams, according to the following table:

Average of the marks*	Points
Equal to 18 and less than 22	3
More than or equal to 22 and less than 23	4
More than or equal to 23 and less than 24	5
More than or equal to 24 and less than 25	6
More than or equal to 25 and less than 26	7
More than or equal to 26 and less than 27	8
More than or equal to 27 and less than 28	9
More than or equal to 28 and less than 29	10
More than or equal to 29 and less than 30	11
More than 30**	12

**, calculated with the Italian 30-point scale, i.e. passing grades between 18 to 30 cum laude (considered as 33).*

b. Possible publications - max 3.5 points, with evaluation of: (i) relevance to the themes of the PhD Course in Food Systems; (ii) typology (article in indexed scientific journal, article in unindexed magazine, poster or conference intervention); (iii) positioning of the candidate in the list of authors (first name, middle name, corresponding author or other positioning). A maximum of 1 point is provided for each publication.

- c. **Professional experiences and other titles - max 2 points**, calculated also considering the duration (longer than 6 months or less than 6 months). A maximum of 0.5 points is given for each experience.
- d. **Erasmus or international experiences - max 2.5 points**, calculated also considering the duration (longer than 3 months or less than 3 months). A maximum of 2 points is provided for each experience.

Criteria for the evaluation of the research project - max 10 pts

The research project presented by each candidate, once established the relevance to the PhD course in Food Systems, is evaluated on the basis of:

- Completeness of the structure (clear indication of objectives, schematization of work in work packages, etc.): max 4 points.
- Methodological rigor: max 3 points.
- Originality: max 2 points.
- Feasibility: max 1 point.

Criteria for the interview

Maturity and professional skills of the candidate, knowledge of the topic, synthesis ability, aptitudes of the candidate for scientific research, and personal motivation.
