How to record your powerpoint presentation

- 1. Open the powerpoint presentation you want to record.
- 2. Click "Slide Show", "Record Slide Show", "Start recording from the beginning"
- 3. Select your desired options (normally the standard options are fine so normally you do not deselect anything) and click "Start recording"
- 4. Start speaking ("Welcome to my presentation blabla...") and do what you always do during your presentation
- 5. In the lower left corner, you can make your mouse into a laser-type pointer
- 6. During recording, there will be a small "Recording" window in the upper left corner. You can pause there your recording.
- 7. At the end of your presentation, you can close the "Recording" window (by clicking the "x").
- 8. Go to "Save as", and save your recording as a Powerpoint Show ".pps".
- 9. Open your .pps file to see if you are happy with the recorded presentation.
- 10. If you are happy, go to "Save as" and save the presentation as an ".mp4" or ".wmv" file.
- 11. Send us (the link to) your mp4 or wmv file.
