INTERNSHIP PROPOSALS GUIDELINES

Master in Cooperation for Sustainable Agrifood Development

The <u>Master in Cooperation for Sustainable Agrifood Development</u> - is organised by the Department of Agrienvironmental Science, Production, Landscape, and Agrienergy of the University of Milano (Italy). At the accomplishment of the academic portion of the course, a mandatory 2-to-3-month internship is proposed to each student, starting from June 2023.

The master offers your organisation the possibility to consider some of the students' profile to design and create specific internship positions. To this aim, we would kindly ask you to participate in our Internship Program and to put forth proposals.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE HOSTING ORGANISATIONS:


- 1. Internships must last at least two months.
- **2.** They must show clearly-defined responsibilities for both the intern and the host organization (country, field, duties, job requirements, possible expenditures, etc.).
- **3.** They must specify the availability of at least one individual able to act as on-site tutor to the intern (here after called external tutor, at least part time).
- **4.** Logistic support to the intern if available (office equipment, possible accommodation, possible reimbursement for travel expenses, other contributions if provided).

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE STUDENT:

- 1. The student will be required to carry out activities according to the educational training project agreed with internal and external tutors;
- 2. The student will be required to elaborate the Master thesis research during his/her internship

CONTRIBUTION FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF MILAN

- 1. The University of Milan will specify the at least one individual able to act as internal tutor to the intern.
- 2. After the internship, the University of Milan will evaluate the intern's performance in collaboration with the external tutor from the hosting institution.
- 3. The school will pay for the students' insurance for the entire duration of the internship.
