## POST DOCTORAL POSITIONS IN LABOUR AND MIGRATION ECONOMICS

Applications are invited for **two post-doctoral positions** in Labour and Migration Economics at the <u>Department of Economics</u>, <u>Management</u>, and <u>Quantitative Methods</u> (<u>DEMM</u>) of the University of Milan.

The positions are funded within the PRIN projects "Regular and irregular migration: origin, arrivals and integration trajectories" coordinated by Prof. Tommaso Frattini, and "From Schools to Labour Markets: Fostering Social Inclusion and Economic Integration of Migrants and Refugees", coordinated by Prof. Francesco Fasani. The selected candidates will work in close collaboration with the two project coordinators.

#### THE POSITION:

- Fixed term **18 months position**, possibly renewable for six more months.
- Gross salary is 26,750 Euros per year. The fellowship is tax-free but subject to 11% social security contributions. The net salary is thus approximately 24,000 Euros per year.
- The fellowship does not involve any teaching.

### **CANDIDATE PROFILE AND REQUIREMENTS:**

- Candidates will have obtained, or be close to obtaining, a PhD in Economics (or related field)
- Candidates are expected to conduct independent research at the highest international standards and to actively collaborate to the research activities of the two projects.
- Expertise in Applied Microeconomics, Labour Economics and the Economics of Migration are preferred requirements.
- Language knowledge: English (knowledge of Italian is NOT required)

## SELECTION AND APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Candidates will be selected on the basis of their qualifications and interviews. On line interviews will be held on February 21, 2024.
- Interested candidates should separately apply for both positions.
